

Ayr Classic Motorcycle Club

Constitution May 2022

01. The club will be called the Ayr Classic Motorcycle Club.
02. The aim of the Club will be to foster an interest in restoration, preservation and regular use of machines of 2 or 3 wheels, any model of which is 15 years of age, or more.
03. The Club will encourage the use and display of the above machines in shows, events and competitions.
04. The office bearers of the Club will be elected by the membership and will comprise of Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. A Show Co-ordinator, Runs Co-ordinator, Newsletter Editor and Webmaster will be co-opted to the Committee if they are not already members. These posts are held for one year. In addition, twelve Committee Members are appointed for a two-year period, six of whom are due to retire each year in rotation.
05. The Annual General meeting will be held in November each year. Members will be notified of the date of the AGM at least seven days before the event.
06. The financial report will be issued at the AGM. An auditor will be elected by the membership at the AGM. The Club's financial year runs from 1st November to 31st October.
07. Any proposed alteration to the constitution, or item to be included in the agenda for the AGM, must be in the hands of the Secretary before the agenda is submitted to the members.
08. An Extraordinary General Meeting can be called by the Committee or at the request, in writing, of at least two thirds of the membership. A quorum for an EGM shall be one quarter of the membership or two thirds if called by the members. Communication can be made by any Club member via the Club newsletter.
09. Application for membership will be via the website or on the appropriate form. The Club holds the right to refuse membership without explanation. In exceptional circumstances the Committee will hold the right to withdraw the membership of any one, or more, persons who act in a manner prejudicial to the image and reputation of the Club.
10. The Club will attempt to operate a mutual aid scheme to encourage the interchange of spares, special tools and technical advice.
11. The Club will encourage liaison with other similarly disposed Clubs.
12. The Club fess will be revised and modified, if necessary, at the AGM. Failure to pay the Club fees by the 31st December following the AGM may mean loss of membership unless acceptable reason is offered.
13. Members who have 25 years membership and who have been a stalwart of the Club will be considered for the position of Honorary member at the discretion of the Committee.
14. Should the Club be wound up, any monies remaining will be given to charity or charities chosen by the outgoing committee.

This constitution discussed, amended and agreed by the membership at the AGM on 8th November 2022.
